



PATIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Each patient treated at the Gateway Surgical Center has the responsibility to:
- Provide a complete and accurate medical history including medications, over the counter products, dietary supplements, and any allergies or sensitivities
- Follow the treatment plan established by the physician, including instructions of nurses and other health care professional as they carry out the physician's orders
- Arrange for a responsible adult to drive you home and stay with you for 24 hours after the procedure/surgery (as may be required by your physician).
- Fulfill financial responsibility, for all services received, as determined by the patient's Insurance carrier.
- Provide the surgery center with all information regarding third party Insurance coverage
- Behave respectfully toward all health care professionals, as well as other patients
- Keep your appointment and notify the facility if you are unable to do so
- Read and understand all consents you sign. Please ask questions for clarification before signing consents
- Carry identification with you
- Let us know if you do not understand any part of your treatment Ask questions and take part in your healthcare decisions.
- Let us know when you are having pain or when your pain is not being managed
- Respect the Center's property and equipment
